## Counting the Cost (Luke 14:25-33) *continued*

When I came to the Lord after a deep breaking and God was preparing me in ministry, I never consciously asked the Lord to change any specific area in me. Once I was ordained as a minister, I realised that He changed many different things in me, but some things had not changed at all.

Years ago I went back to my high school 40<sup>th</sup> class reunion. I had never been to one before. I met people I had not seen for forty years. In a sense it was funny because the moderator got up and said that he had some news for those in attendance. He told them that JC Hedgecock was present and that he now travelled all over the world as a minister. Everyone burst out laughing. He asked me if I would say a blessing before we ate. They still thought I was faking it when I said the blessing! On such occasions they always nominated someone who they thought had changed the most since high school. There was only one nomination - me! God had changed me.

I thought about this and also realised that there are things in me that are exactly the same as they were when I was in school. I told the Lord I did not understand because I was not yielding to Him then and I did not understand why He had not changed some parts of my character. The Lord told me that He had formed those things in me when I did not know what He was doing. He brought events and people into my life to influence me and my character because he wanted those things in me. Whatever events and people brought into my life that He did not want He had removed.

One of the things that stood out to me was the honesty and integrity I saw in a cousin of mine. I wanted to emulate him. He taught me that I should do the right thing whatever the cost. (This cousin, a local police officer, had taken me under his wing because he saw that I was in rebellion to my father and was getting involved in activities that would end up with me being in jail.) He knew I would be excited by the prospect of working with him so he made me his deputy. He taught me about honesty but he also taught me how to drink moonshine whiskey without getting drunk. (Obviously God eliminated that part!) God left in me the things that He wanted.

I asked the Lord if He could show me other examples of what He had done in me that I was unaware of at the time. He showed me that most of the people He picked to plant something in my life were not Christians. That was amazing to me. Everything I needed to know about Christianity,

the Lord showed me directly or used my dad to tell me. The Lord did not use anyone else in this area but there were strengths of character He wanted to develop in me. He allowed

me to endure hardness as a good soldier, not to be afraid of the unknown. He gave me an adventurous spirit; there was a time when the more frightening a thing was the more I wanted to do it. This developed some things in me that made me different from others.

God was already creating in me what He wanted from the time I was a child because I accepted Jesus when I was six years old. I really loved the Lord until I was about ten or twelve when my heart began to rebel. God saw who I was; He knew who I was called to be. I believe He determined who I was to be before I was ever born. I had a calling but that did not mean I had met the conditions necessary to be chosen. The cost to walk in my calling was getting rid of my old Adam nature.

**We have to get settled who is going to be Lord.** I thought it was settled in me and I was stubborn in believing that. It took a serious „knocking off my donkey“ experience to sort me out. But that is the cost. The cost to have Jesus Christ as your Lord and your Friend, to be a child and heir of God, to inherit God's Kingdom now and throughout eternity, to rule and reign through eternity, to have all the blessings of God, to have Him create in you a unique original individual unlike anyone else; all those blessings are conditional on your willingness to pay the cost. This will not happen as long as you are lord in the old nature.

You cannot separate your being lord from the old nature because you cannot be lord in the new nature that God wants to create in you. The answer to this is not trying to stop being lord but removing the only place where you can be lord. Get rid of the Adam nature, kill and bury it and then you will have no place to go to. It is like burning the bridge behind you; you cannot go back. If the old nature is dead and buried you cannot go back to it. However, you can resurrect it if you choose to do so. How many times have you done this? Every time you yield to the old nature, you give it energy and power until it stands up and gets strong. God knows what percentage of your life is spent in the old nature and it is supposed to be zero! At the very least, living in the new nature should be 90% or more. Maybe you get out occasionally but that should be the exception to the rule not the rule itself! If you get out of the new nature it should only be because satan tricked you and you are ignorant that he did something to get you out. As soon as you realise this you should deal with it and get back where you should be.

All God requires of you is that you give up something that has already been condemned and has no value in eternity; something that is temporal and will not be raptured with you. Your flesh is never going to heaven. The only thing that is going is your spirit and the new nature and what has been developed into a new creation in Christ. All the things in your mind that were put there by satan in the Adam nature will be deleted. You are not going to heaven with any of that in your mind. The only part of your memory that you are going with is the mind of Christ that you have. That is all!

Do you realise that He said when you are raptured, corruption is put off and incorruption is put on? In the twinkling of an eye we shall know even we are known. All sin and flesh will be deleted. All that is left is what has come from Christ. The Lord will download all that is known about us by Him, no more errors or lies you believed. All that will be gone and you will be there in your new nature at the level to which it has been developed. There is no getting around the fact that there are blessings and benefits to those who have bowed the knee and obey the Lord, and there are penalties for those who disobey Him. How He balances that out is His decision. One thing is for certain, He will give honour where honour is due. It will not be the same for every person like everyone hopes; He will not clear the slate and give everyone exactly the same reward. You cannot take God's grace in one situation and say that it will apply to everything. That is not how God works. God gives grace where He chooses, not where we choose! You can either meet the conditions God has set and automatically guarantee benefits in eternity or not meet the conditions and hope that you receive God's grace to get part of it. It is a gamble when you do not do things God's way!

Once I was asked if I was „Pre, Mid or Post“ (referring to when the rapture might take place in relation to the tribulation). I said, „I am none of those. I am Pan.“ They asked what I meant. I said I believed it was all going to pan out! I asked if I could ask them a question because I knew they were all „Pre“. I said, „Suppose we get every Christian to believe that the Lord is coming back in the middle but the Father has already decided that the Son will get the Bride at the beginning. Will you hear the trumpet sound at the beginning and say you do not want to go? Alternatively, suppose we all believe He is coming in the beginning and He comes in the middle. Will you be prepared to wait? Will you have the spiritual strength to wait until He comes? I want to be prepared for Him whenever He decides to come!“

The timing of the rapture is a mystery. It does not matter what you and I decide, it is what God decides that will happen! I am going to agree with the Lord on whatever He decides to do and I am going to be prepared. Those who believe He is going to come at the beginning, I hope are right as that will be the easiest time for us. But in case they are not right, I am going to be willing and ready to go to the middle and, if that is not it, I am going to go to the end because whenever that trumpet sounds, I want to go whenever He comes!

This is one of the problems with the Body of Christ. We make doctrines out of mysteries and nobody can prove for sure which one is correct. We divide ourselves and we are not in agreement. We say we cannot be of one mind and satan uses this foolishness to separate believers into opposing groups when we should be in fellowship with one another.

God does not change. He made Jesus Lord and put everything in Heaven and earth under His Son. It is not just on earth and in the Church. Jesus is Lord of everything in the universe! I do not know if there is anything else in the universe that we do not know about, but if there is, Jesus is over it! When God creates a new Heaven and a new earth, or even if He creates hundreds of them, Jesus will be over them!

Even though God is all powerful, our lives indicate that we do not believe that God can mend our little lives. This is insulting to God to even think of; it is even more insulting to suggest that we can do a better job being in control of our lives than He can. How arrogant is it that we think that way? How can we proclaim to be smart yet not figure out how dumb we are? “He that trusts in his own heart, is a fool” (Prov. 28:26). Jeremiah 17:9 AMPC says that the heart is deceitful, exceedingly perverse, corrupt and mortally sick. And we trust in that? How foolish! Our heart is in a condemned state and we think we can trust it. That is ridiculous but our pride has convinced us that we are smart enough to do just that.

The more intelligent you think you are and the more capable you think you are of running your own life, the easier it is for satan to deceive you. I do not want to be a fool and I do not like someone making me a fool. Do you? As long as you hang on to your lordship, you are letting satan make you a fool. I have done a lot of foolish things in my life and I did that for too many years but one day God changed me. At least one time in my life I did something smart and from that point on I got smarter and smarter because I only did what He said. I did not really get smart. It was the One in me Who was smart and I simply started letting Him make the choices.

How many blessings of God have you lost and it is now too late to retrieve them? From the time you became a child of God, He set out a plan for your life to take you from blessing to blessing. That happens when He is Lord. But when you are lord, you get the minimum survival provision but not the added blessings. How much of our inheritance have we given away because we stubbornly kept control? What is so sad about that is that we do not want to give up the control but the reality is that we do not have any control to begin with! In the flesh, you are not in control; satan is in control. The only reason satan does not wipe you out is because God, through His grace, has put a hedge around you that limits how much satan can do. You are denying God’s Lordship yet He still protects you enough to not let the enemy destroy you. But He also allows satan to affect us because whatever you sow you are also going to reap. God still limits even that! God is constantly trying to get our attention to get us to „Wake Up“.

**What is your rebellion costing you?** Do not be mistaken about this. If Jesus is not the absolute Lord of your life you are in rebellion against God. It does not matter how spiritual you act or how much you go to church or attend conferences. It does not matter how many good works you do. You are in rebellion. If you do all kinds of good works yet you will not submit to God, you are a hypocrite. You are not even being honest about your rebellion. No one may be able to see the hypocrisy of your silent rebellion but that does not mean it doesn’t exist. At least if it is open rebellion you are being honest!

I was either hot or I was cold. You can only be one or the other. I served the flesh for years and then I learned to serve God. I did not serve both at the same time. I completely yielded to one or completely yielded to the other. You have got to get out of that middle place as it is the worst place to be. This is where satan wants you to be because this costs you the most. At least while you are cold, you get more grace if you are acting ignorantly and in unbelief. Sadly, we often know what is required but we choose not to do it because of what we think it might cost us and we do not want to give up control.

How many of God’s blessings have you let go of and it is too late to retrieve them? Ecclesiastes 3.1 says there is a time and place for everything under the sun. God establishes His Word in seasons but if you are lord of that season then whatever God wanted to do in that season does not get done. You can repent in the next season but you do not go back to the season that has passed. Do not be deceived by a false belief that you can always repent and that will fix everything. God will allow you to repent and gain back your inheritance of having fellowship with Him but the time you were out of His presence cost you something. **Do not be deceived into believing your rebellion is without cost.** Yes, God will forgive you but you always suffer loss when living in the flesh. Rebellion and disobedience always have a cost and the most valuable cost is time. You cannot get time back; there is nothing you can do to regain time that has been lost. Only by God’s grace and favour can loss be turned to gain.

The question is, “What are you going to do with the time you have left?” How much more time are you going to lose before you get around to settling who is going to be Lord? From the day you got saved you should not have lost any time over that issue. **When Jesus actually becomes the functional Lord of your life, then He will start working in your life where you are.** If you are willing, then He may help you catch up with some of what you have lost in the past. He will not overwork you; you will not have to study 24 hours a day. He will still give you rest in His timing.

Even though God allowed some rest for me, I asked Him if I could instead use that time to study and get prepared spiritually because I had lost so much time. I used those extra hours and asked Him to take me back and show me where things had gone wrong. He showed me exactly how I allowed error to get into my life and how to repent of it. He showed me my stumbling blocks and then He showed me what I should have done instead. He showed me how to turn stumbling blocks into stepping stones. That part of my past changed from a negative to a positive!

I dealt with every wound that was in me and why hurt and bitterness was still in my life, what I did wrong and how to repent. He healed those wounds and they were no longer an issue to me because I learned something from them. Over a period of a few

years I came to the point where I had redeemed all the time satan had stolen from me. When I started the ministry I was where I should have been if I had been obedient on a regular schedule and I have maintained that for over forty years.

If you cannot maintain what God is telling you to do in the present then you are not going to be able to sort out the past. You will never be able to redeem time if you are not able to deal with the issues that prevent Him from being your absolute Lord in the present. **You must get to the point where you love Him so much, you only want to do what He says.**

One of the things that hinders us is the battle with the thoughts satan puts in our minds. You can get to the point where he is unable to do this. Then you are not wasting time battling with him and instead all your energy can go into doing what the Lord says. This is a process. The more you become the unique person God has created you to become, the less access satan has to you. Eventually you can get to the place where God wants you to be and you will begin to destroy the work of the devil. Remember Matthew 10.41. If you give a prophet a glass of water you get a prophet's reward. It does not matter what part you are in the Body of Christ, because whatever the Body accomplishes, you are a part of that work.

God is not a respecter of persons. He is looking for a people who are faithful. If I am preaching and I am supposed to be doing something else, then I am not being faithful. If you try to do my job but you are called to help with the books, then you are not being faithful with what you are called to do. If you are not doing what you are supposed to be doing, then everything you do is a dead work. Even if God uses what you do to the benefit of others, you will still suffer spiritual loss because you were not authorised to do what you were doing.

1 Corinthians 3.13 talks about whether what you do is spiritual or not. If your work passes God's test of fire, then you will receive a reward. But if your work burns up, you will lose the reward you should have had even if your soul passes through the fire. Every work will be tested by fire. I do not know what the reward will be but if God says there will be a reward, then it must be worth having!

I have mentioned many times that nothing you do in the old nature will build up treasure in heaven but everything you do in the new nature will. What you do now is determining where you will function in eternity. We do not know what the reward is. It could be where you are going to rule and reign. Every one of us has an account in heaven. Do you have any idea of what is in your account? Jesus said to store up treasures in heaven rather than on earth where it can all be stolen. Hebrews says that God is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. If Jesus is saying you should store up treasures in heaven and there is a way of testing what you do, why would you want to do anything other than what He says? When Jesus told us to store up treasures in heaven, that was a commandment! How many of you are consciously thinking about laying up treasures in heaven? We must study God's Word and seek His directions for our lives so that we can obey this commandment.

In the early years, the Lord made me do a study on the glory of God. I noticed that He seemed very particular about someone touching His glory. There are stories in the Bible where people died because they touched God's glory because all glory belongs to Him. I knew nothing about glory and what it was and why it was so important. I told the Lord I did not want to touch His glory and that I wanted Him to have all the glory, that I had no idea how it worked and what it was. So I asked Him what it meant that all glory was due to Him. The Spirit spoke very clearly and me that glory due to Him meant that all credit was due to Him.

I mentioned to Him that He had called me into ministry to be His servant and work for Him and that I was going to do whatever He told me to do. I told Him that when I obeyed Him, did He want all the credit for what I did and He said, "Yes". I already knew God could read my thoughts so, wishing to be honest, I told Him that I loved Him and would serve Him. I said that He could have all the credit, but it did not seem fair that if I was doing the work, it seemed odd that He was going to get all the credit. He agreed with me that it would not be fair. He then told me He wanted the credit for the work He was going to do through me. He told me that He never asked me to do the work to start with and that He was preparing me so that I would allow Him to do the work through me. He told me that I could have the credit for all the work that originated in me, but that it had no eternal value. He told me if I would give Him the credit for what He did through me, then He would make me a vessel of honour in His house and He would bless and reward me. He wanted to work through me but He wanted to do all the work. If I would allow Him to do this, then He would honour me and bless me.

You have no idea how hard that was for me. Everything in me wanted to help Him. It made me feel vulnerable because what would happen if He did not show up in a situation? I did not feel ready. **The truth is, we are not meant to add to or take away**

**from what He tells us to do.** The more we can stop trying to help God, then the greater vessel of honour we will be. To do this we must purify ourselves from all the carnal things in us (2 Timothy 2.21). Then we will be chosen as vessels of honour to do the Father's work.

I feel this is what the Lord showed me about the works we are doing; everything is going to be tested. Anything I have initiated with my being lord will be tested and the test is, "Did God do that through me or did I do it? Did it initiate from me?" You see, if I did it, then the glory belongs to me and not to God. Therefore it will have no eternal value. However, if what I do is what God did through me, then it will carry an eternal reward. I realised that this not only has to do with spiritual things but rather with everything I do.

We have no idea how valuable each reward in Heaven will be. It is easy for me to preach but what if He asks me to do something I would find more difficult? Is it possible that such a command would produce a greater reward because it is not as easy for me to do? It is the same for all of us. We need to realise that the devil speaks to our minds so that we have opinions on what we can or cannot do and what counts or does not count. The issue is not whether or not it looks spiritual but whether or not He was Lord of what we did. Did we honour Him by allowing Him to be Lord of what we did? Did we allow Him to direct our steps? Did what we do bring glory to Him?

How much effort have we put into doing good works throughout our lives that are going to burn up because we initiated them? We have no idea what is in our heavenly account and no idea how that is going to affect us in eternity. I guarantee you that it will have a great effect. We do not understand God's value system but there is nothing greater you can do on this earth than to bring glory to God. You cannot bring glory to God if you are not functioning in areas where He has authorised you to be a vessel for His works with the motivation that you love Him.

### **Trip to Mauritius, Madagascar and Southern Africa in September 2016**

When I arrived in Mauritius from Geneva I had the privilege of meeting the leaders of a church that was founded through a lady revivalist. The leaders shared some exciting stories of miracles from the past. I was able to share some truths about walking with God and afterwards spent more time with the senior pastor. That evening I spoke at the local Baptist church at 7.30pm. The meeting started with a short prayer and the Lord had me speak about trusting the witness of the Spirit and not using natural discernment. Many of the people were touched and convicted. Many seemed to understand and purchased books. Because of a water leak in the house of my host, I had to stay in a different home which was at the coast with a spectacular view and sunset. In the morning it was possible to see waves breaking on the coral reef surrounding the Island of Mauritius. I had to leave early and meet one pastor at the airport before flying on a direct flight to Madagascar. Only last year I was here and it was visa free. On arrival this time I had to pay 27€ for a visa. Fortunately, I had the correct change and was able to get my visa quickly despite some long queues.

In Madagascar my first task was to collect books that were translated and printed locally. They had printed about 11 copies, which was reasonable. However, the printer made a mistake and the cover was upside down! The books had to be re-printed overnight. The manager apologised and worked with some of his staff throughout the night to get them ready for a seminar in the morning where I was speaking on Wednesday. That night we left for a meeting at the university and just reached the place on time despite the traffic and changing cars but we did not have time to eat before the meeting. Each place where I spoke was supposed to take up a small offering but the lunch time meeting was not normally taking up offerings for outside speakers. I mentioned that if they wanted me to come back they should take up an offering so they did! That night although I got a few hours sleep, at midnight I reached the airport and was very tired. At the exchange counter I was so tired I dropped \$60 and someone took this quickly when I was not looking! This was not nice when I know the people had given their best to help me with some travelling expenses!

I then flew with Kenya Airways to Johannesburg and then changed to another airline to Gaborone in Botswana. The only way to reach Gaborone was to leave Antanarivo at 2am. I had two evening meetings in Gaborone where I spoke at the Independent Assemblies of God Church. This gave me time to rest during the day on Friday. On Saturday I travelled to Blantyre in Malawi where I was the guest of a church called Word of Faith Temple of Miracles International in the Chilobwe Township. I had met the host last year and the senior pastor was the religious adviser to the Prime Minister for Malawi! Despite this I still had to pay \$75 for a visa on arrival. Malawi was previously visa free for British citizens. I had two meetings on Sunday and then on Monday a lunch time meeting in the city led by a lady pastor. The lunch time meeting was nearly 200 people and they were willing to take up an offering for my visit as well.

After Malawi I travelled back to South Africa where the schedule had changed significantly. I did not have time to visit Lesotho and Bloemfontein as I had planned because of a flight change. I also had to fly at 9am on Friday morning to Dubai. I was only scheduled to speak twice in the evening but also shared at morning prayer meetings starting at 6am each day while I was in Vereeniging. These meetings were attended faithfully by at least 12 people. The founder of the church started this church through prayer and his members were following his example. The meetings in the evening attracted some local preachers and one pastor from Lesotho but he had to leave early before I met him. On Friday morning we had to leave at 4.45am to be sure that we did not get stuck in the traffic around Johannesburg and not miss my flight to Dubai.

This was a great trip and on the way home I was also able to speak in Zurich on Sunday morning and Cologne on Sunday evening. The people and the leaders I spoke to afterwards really liked the message in Zurich. Also in Cologne the people were very open to hear more. I then stayed the night there and travelled directly to East Midlands the next morning. The trip lasted about two weeks and two days and I covered seven countries.

## Trip to Wiesbaden and trip with Keith Jenkins to Austria and Croatia, 31.10.2016 – 03.11.2016.

My wife and I went by train to Wiesbaden, because we felt we should hear Joseph preach there. Both of us were very touched. I felt God's love very strongly and had tears in my eyes, especially when Joseph spoke about the gift of eternal life and that we can know Jesus. When he is speaking I can feel how deep his relationship with the Lord is and how precious the gift of eternal life is for him. On the same day we went to Frankfurt and slept in a youth hostel.

I prayed and felt that God wanted me to spend some of my holiday traveling with Keith. I felt it should be this trip and I also felt that I should go by hitch hiking to Vienna. I went by hitchhiking from Frankfurt to Vienna. He directed me where to go and whom to ask. God led me into some situations, where I could report on how I got to know Jesus Christ. One man asked for prayer. We did this in his car. After praying the whole car was densely filled with the presence of God. We both could perceive it. We were still for about 3 minutes and just enjoyed His presence. The man was touched, had tears in his eyes, and could feel the peace of God. I gave him a New Testament and my "Wake Up, Time is Running Out" book, with my contact details. He called Maria Schaffer to meet us. She came and collected me. It was an encouragement for both her and her husband.

We collected Keith Jenkins the next morning at the Vienna airport. Maria Schaffer hosted us and drove us to the meetings. He spoke in two home groups; one near to Graz, one near to Vienna. Keith preached about the "Witness of the Word". Both groups received the message well. Some bought books. The next day, early in the morning, we went by bus to Croatia, Osijek. The pastor of the church picked us up when we arrived at the bus station and invited us for dinner in a restaurant. Keith preached in the church, again about the "Witness of the Word". The message was powerful. The people received it well. Afterwards we had good fellowship and encouragement. We shared one room.

The next day we went with car sharing to Zagreb. The young man picked us up very early. He was hungry to know how Keith became a preacher, and Keith shared the whole story from getting saved to meeting Joseph and finally being ordained by God to teach. I got out at a fuel station near to Zagreb on the high way and went back home to Germany by hitchhiking, because I felt that was the will of God for me. Keith took the plane from Zagreb back home to the UK. God brought me home, within 12 hours. I hitchhiked to Gera, a town near to the place I live and took the train back home. God opened a lot of situations where I could testify that Jesus Christ is alive, that He is risen, that one can get to know Him in a very intimate and deep way, that one can hear His voice. Jesus showed me the people I should talk with.

#### Joseph's and Keith's visits to Holland/Belgium.

On Friday 30<sup>th</sup> October I picked up Joseph from Schiphol airport at around 17:30. The timing was good since Joseph only waited 3 minutes for me to arrive. We first drove to a highway restaurant to have something to eat. I asked the church if they would be able to give us a place to sleep but instead they booked each of us a room in a 4 star hotel. The normal price was 90 Euro per night, but these rooms were not available at that moment, so they gave us 165 Euro rooms for the same price!

We went into my room and looked at all the luxury, then going out I left my digital key inside and closed the door. Joseph's humour showed as he said, "At last you thought you entered heaven and within one minute you're out again." Referring to entering the Kingdom of God and learning to stay there. This was for me a visual teaching I will not forget. That evening he spoke with Keith over the phone to ask what subject Keith had preached on in the beginning of the year in the same church.



On Saturday morning we had a delicious breakfast. I ate a lot because I felt we would not get any food that afternoon, which was correct. We drove 5 minutes to the church, the meeting started at 13:00 and ended at 18:00. Joseph had two sessions of about one hour each and spoke about the “Kingdom of God NOW”, “The Spirit of Truth”, “The Difference Between Natural and Spiritual” and “Signs of the Last Days”. Elke Meyer came all the way from Germany to help with the book table and offered people who were interested extra help by leaving their email addresses.

I did the translation into Dutch which was not that easy because of the speed of the preaching, but the message was clear. Joseph also told me that afterwards a man spoke words which showed he did not have ears to hear. It is for us a lesson to not only listen but to watch that satan will not rob the seed being sown. That is why making notes or recordings are very helpful. We had to leave at 16:30 during the meeting, so I drove Joseph back to the airport for his flight back to Frankfurt. Then I drove to the South of Holland.

Two days later, on Monday, I picked up Keith from Aachen. He also came from Germany but by bus. We drove immediately to Verviers in Belgium and arrived at 17:40, just in time for the meeting where he spoke about “The Witness of the Word”, “How We Should Read the Bible Without Using Our Own Understanding” and “Letting the Holy Spirit Bring Back to our Mind Whatever He Decides”. After the meeting we had a late dinner at Alain and Collette’s house, the pastors of the church.

We arrived at 23:30 at my home in Maastricht and left at 4:00 to the airport in Cologne. From there Keith flew to Austria.

I noticed, in the itinerary that Keith had to wake up very early every night that week, leaving him with short nights of 3 or 4 hours of sleep. I asked him how he was able to get along with such few hours of sleep. His reply was that he could do it by the grace of God and by cleaning his body inside.

After I had dropped Keith at 5:30 AM at Cologne Airport, I drove to an SOLM meeting in Solingen which started at 10:30. There I was able to listen to Joseph again. Then, in the evening, I drove home and was satisfied that all things worked out well.
